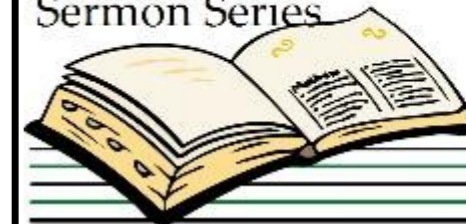


CRESTWOOD DAY AT LEGENDS GAME

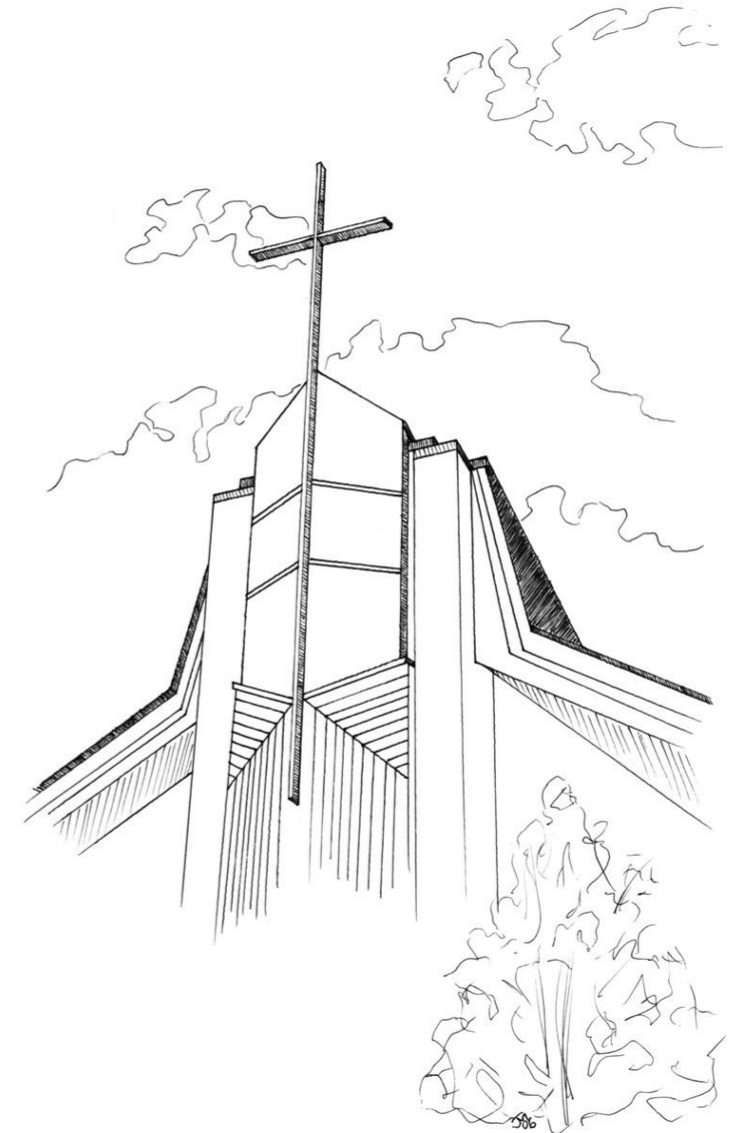
