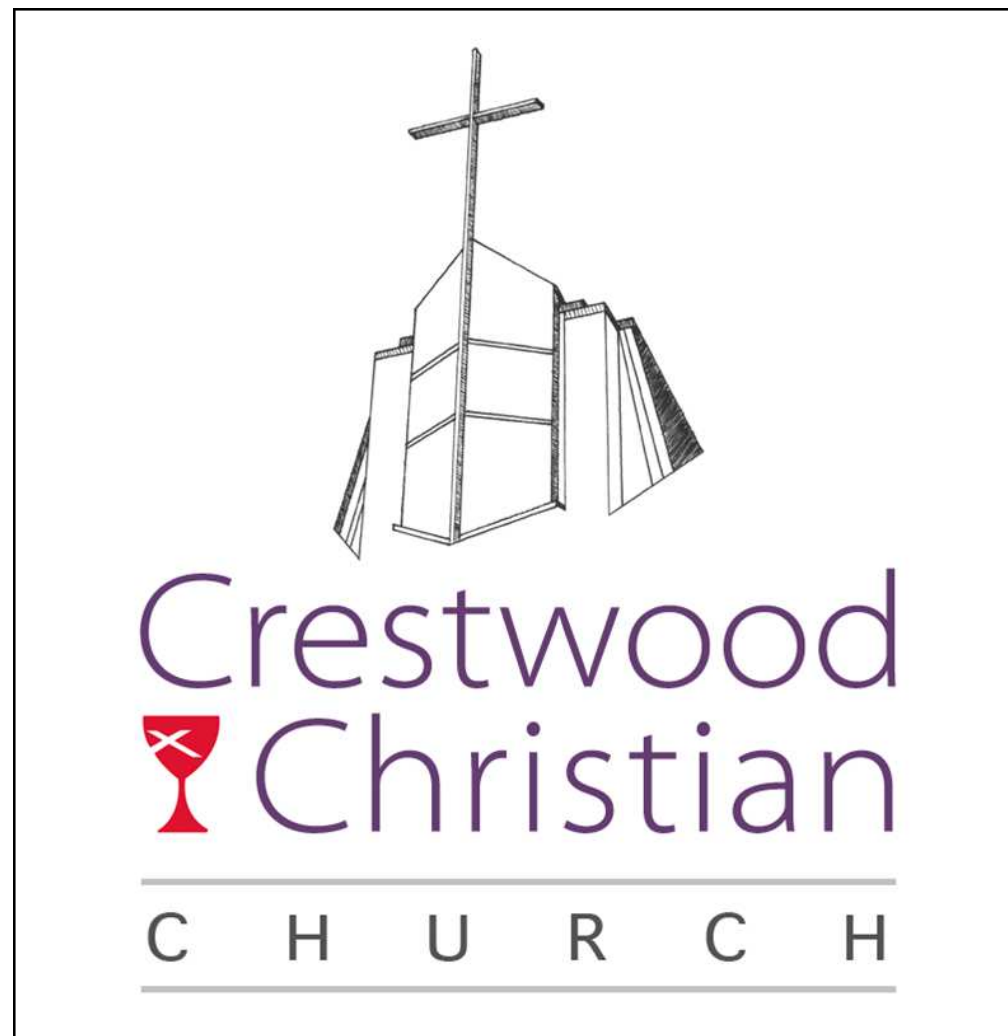

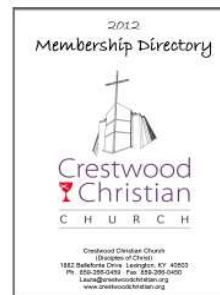

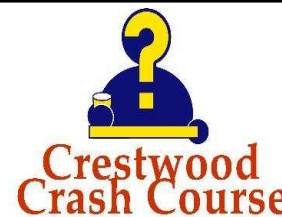
**AGENCY RECIPIENTS FOR THE
