

Posted Rules of Appropriate Conduct

- Every person is a child of God and should be treated as such.
- Everyone is expected to follow the guidelines for use of the church facilities.
- Disrespectful or vulgar language is not permitted.
- Appropriate attire must be worn at all times. Offensive or degrading logos may not be worn in the church facility.
- The use of alcohol, tobacco products and illegal drugs is not permitted in the church.
- Anyone under the influence of a controlled substance will be asked to leave the facility.
- Soccer may not be played in the gymnasium at any time.
- If you are assigned a particular classroom in the building, you must only use that room, unless re-assigned by the Church Office. If you need to change rooms, you must contact the office for permission to do so.
- Groups intending to do arts and crafts will be assigned to the Arts and Crafts room. No arts and crafts may be in any other room.
- Crestwood Church Office or Mission Center attendants have final authority on issues of conduct.
- The church reserves the right to ask anyone to leave if they demonstrate an unwillingness to follow these posted signs and guidelines for use of the church.
- Specific guidelines for use are posted in many parts of the Mission Center. **Posted guidelines must be followed at all times. Failure to comply may result in privileges to use the facilities being revoked.**

Any groups or individuals violating any of this policy will be given up to two warnings. The third infraction will result in loss of church usage privileges. Certain violations may result in immediate revocation of privileges.
