CHURCH REOPENING UPDATE

Greetings, Crestwood! We continue to pay attention to all the information available about the possibility of reopening the church building for Sunday worship and other use. Despite the call from the national level for churches to reopen, we are not at a point to be able to do this in such a way that fully protects our worshippers. There are many considerations to take into account when we talk about inperson Sunday worship, and at this point, a church the size of Crestwood faces several obstacles to making that happen (see Kory's article in the June 1 *Crest*).

Therefore, Crestwood will continue to postpone in-person worship on Sunday mornings for an indefinite period of time. We'll continue to explore the issue and all the aspects involved, but will only consider Sunday morning gatherings when we know everyone who attends can do so without fear of getting sick or infecting others. In the meantime, we will continue to offer online worship, devotions, and other means of connection.

We are also continuing to work with our outside groups to discern the right time to invite them back into our building. Even with small groups, there are issues of cleanliness and sanitization that must be observed. Many of the groups have their own guidelines (like the Boy Scouts), while other groups are still working out those logistics.

At our most recent Board meeting, we suggested creating a task force to work on issues of sanitization and reopening. The staff will head this team, but if you would like to serve on it, please contact Kory and let him know. As always, we welcome your input and feedback as we try our best to be faithful to our calling to serve God and this wonderful congregation.
