

In these strange times, it seems everything is in flux and that includes the work on our Habitat house this year. Lexington Habitat for Humanity suspended the work of volunteers due to the virus, but part of their staff has been working on the Disciples' house (Crestwood's 34th sponsored Habitat house).

Noella and her family will be the homeowners of the Disciples' house, located at 519 Willy Street. Originally from the Republic of the Congo, Noella has a son (17) and two daughters (17 and 14). Noella's husband died before she left the Congo for refugee camps so she is a single parent. After Noella's sister passed away, she took in her two nieces (16 and 13), so the family of six will share the home.

We may be in a pandemic but the crying need for decent housing for everyone is still with us. You can help by making a donation. 




