The thought of a "spiritual discipline" may conjure up images of a monk in a brown robe praying 23 hours a day or a religious zealot living in poverty as a missionary in a third-world country. But actually, spiritual disciplines are simply ways we stay in relationship with God. They are disciplines because we have to intentionally focus on practicing them. As we do, we become closer to the people God created us to be. After all, the word "discipline" comes from the same root as "disciple."

EMERGENCY RESPONSE ITEMS AND DELIVERIES

Many of the young single moms served by Step By Step are financially burdened. Since March 2020, Step By Step has been delivering needed supplies to the homes of their young

families on a regular basis. The need has continued to grow as many have been out of work due to reduced hours or layoffs, inadequate funding for childcare, or because they need to stay home with their children due to nontraditional instruction (NTI). These single-headed households are struggling, in need of items they cannot do without, such as diapers and wipes, hand sanitizer, cleaning supplies, and more. Crestwood Local Outreach has donated \$500 to the COVID response fund at Step By Step. If you would like to purchase items or help Step By Step make COVID regulation safe deliveries, see link below.
