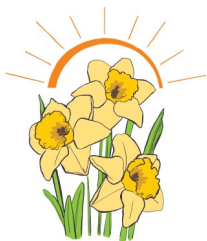


EASTER SUNDAY IN-PERSON WORSHIP



Good news...Easter is coming! Your church staff is hard at work planning multiple safe in-person worship services for Easter Sunday. For those who are not comfortable gathering in person, the last three worship services will be livestreamed through our YouTube page.

Because only 125 people can fit safely in the sanctuary at one time, an overflow area in the gym will be provided for 100 additional people. Children's Church will be offered at the 10:00 AM and 11:15 AM services. If you do not have children, please consider attending an earlier service to make room for the families that will use these services. We hope to make room for everyone who wants to worship in-person and to prioritize church members for these services. In the future, we look forward to opening wide the doors and issuing a hearty "Y'all come!" If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask. Natalie's Sisters needs: Individual Boost/juice, snack bags, tuna or chicken salad packets or kits, chips, crackers, nuts, candy bars, pudding, snack cakes, fruit cups, apple sauce, raisins, peanut butter & crackers, Beanie Weenies (pop-top), Vienna sausages, protein bars. Toiletry Kits each with travel size deodorant, soap or shower gel, shampoo, conditioner. Baby wipes or wash cloth, toothpaste & toothbrush, lotion, razors, Kleenex, nail polish, Chapstick, etc. Leggings, long sleeve tees.

The Well aids survivors of sex trafficking by offering a 2-year house-based program. The Well deals with families not just women; Kentucky is #1 in child abuse.

The Well greatest need: Gift cards (any amount) – Kroger, Walmart, Amazon, bus rides. Also, staple food items such as pasta, rice, ground beef or chicken.
