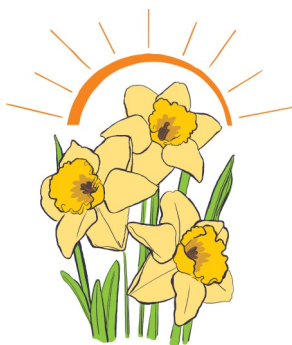


EASTER SUNDAY IN-PERSON WORSHIP
