Martha Seithers took on oversight of the Blessing Box months ago and has tirelessly monitored the contents, usually twice a day, and shopped and replenished as needed. The box continues to be a blessing to those in our community who are struggling in households that are food-insecure.

Because Crestwood's Blessing Box has received a lot of recent traffic, several items need to be restocked. Please visit the box and bless it with a few donations from your pantry.

Suggested donations: canned beef stew, soup, macaroni and cheese, canned/bag tuna, canned/bag chicken, peanut butter, rice, beans, canned pasta, pasta, canned spaghetti sauce, crackers, canned vegetables, canned fruit, instant mashed potatoes, muffin mix, cereal, shampoo and conditioner, body wash, lotion, feminine hygiene products, paper towels, and toilet paper.
