
# CRESTWOOD BLESSING BOX

Crestwood's Blessing Box, located outside the south entrance, is one of ten free pantries located in Lexington. All who visit the box are encouraged to take what they need and leave what they can.





Martha Seithers took on oversight of the Blessing Box months ago and has tirelessly monitored the contents, usually twice a day, and shopped and replenished as needed. The box continues to be a blessing to those in our community who are struggling in households that are food-insecure.
