RETURN TO WEEKLY WORSHIP

Wasn't it wonderful to be back in the sanctuary on Easter Sunday? We're ready to take the next step, which will be experimenting with in-person worship during the first four Sundays of May. We're asking people to use the links below to sign up for the services they would like to attend.

In order to allow room for everyone who wants to worship with us, we're asking people to sign up for only two 10:45 AM services. There's no limit to the number of 8:30 AM services people can attend. We're also allowing people to sign up for a waitlist, in case the 10:45 AM service does not reach capacity. The deadline to sign up for each service will be at noon the Friday before the service. We will be following all the same safety protocols that were used on Easter Sunday.

We're not sure yet if we'll be assigning seats; we'll know more once we see how many people sign up. There is also a separate sign-up for children's church activities. Please know that one of the two services will be livestreamed each Sunday, so you can still worship with us in the safety of your own home. We're hopeful we can worship together in person in ways that keep us both safe and connected. We hope to see you again starting May 2!

- Please sign up for only two 10:45 AM services. You can sign up for as many 8:45 AM services as you like.
- If you have a particular seating location preference or need handicap accessibility, please note it in the comments and we'll do our best to accommodate you.

- Please only sign up for the number of people who will be in the sanctuary for worship.

CRESTWOOD BLESSING BOX

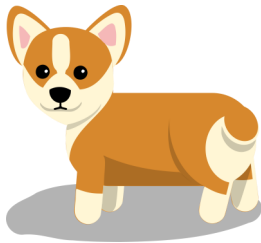
