THURSDAY BIBLE STUDY: THE BOOK OF REVELATION

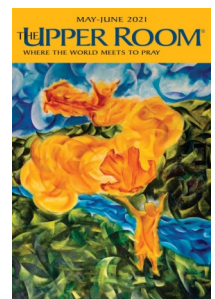
Thursdays @ 11:00 AM

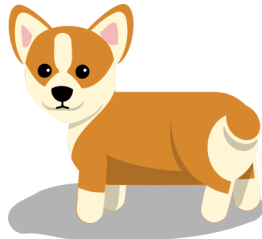

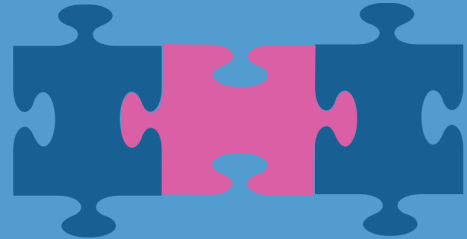
