WORSHIP INFORMATION UPDATE

With the news from the CDC and the governor about changing requirements related to the COVID pandemic, your Crestwood staff and Healthy Church Task Force are in conversation about what we can do to return our worship experience to "normal." We're certainly excited about some of the changes we hope are coming, but also don't want to rush into anything until we know for sure we can keep people safe. To that end, here is our plan moving forward:

- The Healthy Church Task Force will meet this week to discuss new developments, and their decisions will be communicated to you before next Sunday.
- While we still require people to sign up for worship, you are not limited in the number of services you attend.
- Based on information we received from the Fayette County Health Department, we are exploring the possibility of returning to congregational singing and the sharing of communion in safe and healthy ways.

As you can imagine, there are a lot of layers to this whole process. More than anyone, we want worship to return to normal. But we also know that just because we can do something doesn't mean we should if it jeopardizes other people's health. We have to keep everyone's safety in mind, including those who choose not to vaccinate or those (especially our young ones) who are not able to be vaccinated. Just this past week, we had a vaccinated congregation member test positive for COVID (everyone in contact with this person has been notified and the health department applauded our efforts to contact trace and keep our congregation safe). So this is still a real situation with which we are dealing.

Please know we are weighing all information in our decision-making in order to provide the most meaningful worship experience possible. Thank you for your patience, your understanding, and your grace. We will have more news next week about how our worship experience will continue to evolve.
