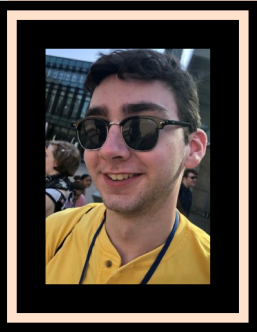

Welcome Our New Choir Members!

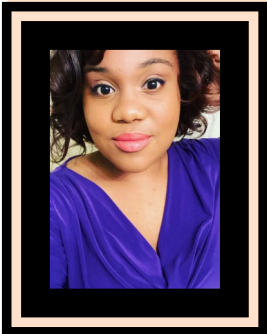
Through a series of generous donations, we are able to welcome four new singers to our choir! They are all music students or professors from local universities. Let's make sure they feel welcome here at Crestwood!
