This outreach program meets people where they are and assists them with basic needs including food, clothing and healthcare. It also provides referrals for shelter, counseling and job training at the Hope Center and other agencies.

Natalie's Sisters extend hope, support, and God's love to sexually exploited women through a first-touch approach providing respite, relationship, and referrals to community resources. **Needs:** individual Boost/juice, snack bags, tuna or chicken salad packets or kits, chips, crackers, nuts, candy bars, pudding, snack cakes, fruit cups, apple sauce, raisins, peanut butter & crackers, Beanie Weenies (pop-top), Vienna sausages, protein bars. **Toiletry Kits** each with travel size deodorant, soap or shower gel, shampoo, conditioner, baby wipes or wash cloth, toothpaste & toothbrush, lotion, razors, Kleenex, nail polish, Chapstick, etc. Leggings, long sleeve tees.

The Well aids survivors of sex trafficking by offering a 2-year house-based program. The Well deals with families, not just women; Kentucky is #1 in child abuse. **The Well greatest need:** Gift cards (any amount) – Kroger, Walmart, Amazon, bus rides. Also, staple food items such as pasta, rice, ground beef or chicken.
