All have the same U.S. tie and all will be living in the same apartment complex. All four have been matched with supporting groups in the community.

Let us hold these folks in our hearts, and in prayer, as they begin new journeys in a new land. This will be the 13th refugee family for which Crestwood has provided direct assistance, with the first being in 1991.
