THE LIVING STORY SERMON SERIES



Dear Friends,

This month has caused us to see more evidence of the brokenness in our country. More shootings, more division, more disasters. It wears on our souls. I find comfort in scripture



but I also find that there is nothing new under the sun. One would think by 2022 we would learn to treat each other a bit better. I subscribe to a daily reading that pops into my inbox in the wee hours of the morning. I want to invite you to read and try what Keith Giles, the author of this devotion, asks of us. Let's do it every day in July and see if that changes us in any way.

READ IT SLOWLY by Keith Giles
Sit down tonight with your Bible. Open it to the
Gospel of Matthew. Find the Sermon on the
Mount. Read it slowly. Listen to Jesus and
what he commands with a new heart. Allow
him to crucify your nationalism and, yes, even
your political affiliation. Ask him to put to
death anything and everything that confuses
his authority with any other. I invite you to
follow Jesus totally untangled from the powers
of this world.

This is a challenge for certain. But isn't that what we have always been called to do as disciples of Christ? We follow Jesus. We are to live into the example he set. This is not an ancient word for ancient time. Read it slowly. Pray. Meditate on it. Let me know if Spirit speaks to you in anyway. What will be crucified in us? What new life will come?

It's hard to believe, but we are just around the corner from one of the most awesome weeks of the year...VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL! As we dive into preparations, volunteer recruitment and crafts galore, here are a few reflections on the importance of VBS in the life of the church:

VBS changes lives. This year's theme is "Monumental: Celebrating God's GREATNESS". Our children have faced years of social distancing, masking, and remote education. We've struggled in our faith, praying for relief from the pain of isolation. Even today, as we discover a new normal, God's love still conquers ALL!

VBS shares God's truth. There's a special moment when children walk into a decorated sanctuary with a look of awe and wonder on their faces. They shine bright knowing this is a sacred space where they feel welcomed, seen and heard. Worship songs stay in our minds until Christmas, and Christmas music sees us through until next summer. VBS leaves a legacy. Some of my earliest VBS memories are of painting wooden puzzles, making soap bibles and being soaked playing games in the summer heat. Fast forward thirty years and the same redheaded girl who crawled underneath church pews is singing that same song with a new generation of kids. Children's ministry is a season of seed planting where a single moment can create a lasting impact.


