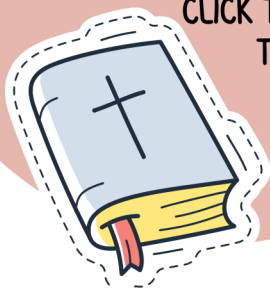
YOUTH SPONSORS NEEDED
