# JANUARY SERVICE PROJECT GREENHOUSE 17

GreenHouse17 is a non-profit organization committed to ending intimate partner abuse in families in the community. The shelter is located in rural Fayette County and serves individuals and families in 17 counties. They are located on a 40 acre farm. Residents farm the land to offer nature based healing, nutritious farm to table produce and job training for survivors. Specially trained crisis counselors are available to help survivors twenty-four hours each day and 365 days a year for crisis intervention and stabilization through individual and group counseling as well as assisting with children's services.

GreenHouse17 can only accept NEW supplies and not previously owned items as their policy dictates due to Covid protocols. NEW items needed are as follows:

Adult and children's toothbrushes Sanitary pads and tampons Shampoo and conditioner Body wash and soap Hair brushes and combs

Textured hair care products such as hair oil, deep conditioners, wide tooth combs

Lotion

Adults and children's underwear

Pull up diapers, all sizes

Cleaning supplies

Paper towels

Toilet paper

NEW Twin size bedding especially "beds in a bag" that includes comforter
