A WORD FROM KORY

If you were in church on Easter Sunday, you know we did something new. We encouraged everyone to wear a nametag so that we could more easily identify each other and get to know other members of our church family. We'll be wearing nametags for the next

five Sundays, then we'll reprise that practice in the fall.

Being able to call someone by name is an important way to get to know them. The comment about being able to "put a name with the face" carries weight as we seek to build relationships and strengthen our church community. Nametags are one of the ways we do this. Another is a pictorial directory, which we are in the process of putting together. Hopefully soon, you'll have more than one way to put names with the faces you see on Sunday morning.

But there's an even more effective way to do this that is a lot older than nametags and directories. Introduce yourself! If you see someone you don't know, or don't know well, walk over to them, extend a hand, and say, "I don't know if we've met before." They may be brandnew guests or long-time members you just haven't gotten to know. Doesn't matter! A kind introduction and warm smile can go a long way toward extending Christ's hospitality.

The most common concern I hear about this practice is, "What if I've already met them and I forgot!" That's where grace abounds. In my 23 years of ministry, I've never heard a person complain, "I had WAY too many people introducing themselves to me on Sunday!" But I've heard a number of visitors to churches lament that no one took the time to say "Hi" or welcome them. Personally, I'd rather err on the side of introducing myself twice than not at all.

When you first came to Crestwood, someone made you feel welcome, so you came back. Now, it's time for you to be that embodiment of hospitality for someone else. Let's commit to living out our mission to "welcome and accept all people" as we greet them on Sunday morning. You never know how much your greeting could change the lives of the people you are welcoming!

APRIL SPOTLIGHT ON SERVICE: STEP BY STEP

Step By Step is an agency in Lexington that was created to empower and embolden young, single mothers to improve their lives, their families and their communities through healing, encouragement, faith and education. The agency was founded in 1995 with a focus on young mothers aged 12 to 24. Step by Step offers support, mentoring, goal setting and crisis intervention as they walk alongside these young mothers and their children.

The agency is requesting gasoline gift cards in the amount of \$25 (from local businesses with SEVERAL locations around town such as Kroger, Walmart, Speedway, Shell). These cards will be used for the young mothers to transport children to doctor appointments. The gift cards should be placed in an envelope marked Step by Step and placed in the Giving Lane (located in the hallway that leads to the Administrative Wing).

JOIN PROPERTY OUTSIDE



LET'S BUILD ANOTHER HABITAT HOUSE!

Spring is upon us and it is time to build another Habitat for Humanity house. Each year Crestwood joins with the other Disciples churches to build a home for a deserving family. What a great tradition! This will be Crestwood's 39th house (Lexington's Disciples for Habitat's 41st house). This year's homeowner will be



Kerrington and her daughter Da'Shiya. Their three-bedroom, two-bath, 1200 square-foot ranch-style home will be located at 721 Florence Avenue. Phase 1 of the construction will begin on Tuesday, April 16, and will continue through May 10. We will be co-sponsors with Valvoline. So, round up your hammer and come out and join us. There are always jobs for the skilled and the unskilled at a Habitat build.

As a sponsor of the house, Disciples for Habitat contributes funds for the purchase of the building materials. This past year Crestwood raised \$18,809.00 as our share of the costs. Not everyone is able physically to work on building a house, but everyone can be a part of this vital program by contributing financially. Our goal for this year is to raise \$20,667.00. With the increase in the cost of home building, this financial support is essential. We will be seeking donations during the month of April. To make a contribution, make out a check to Crestwood with the word 'Habitat' on the memo line, or place cash in a pew envelope and write your name and the word 'Habitat' on the outside.
