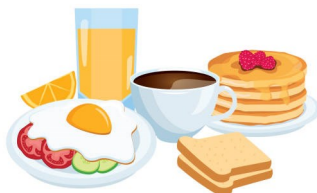
ORDER YOUR TULIPS AND LILIES
