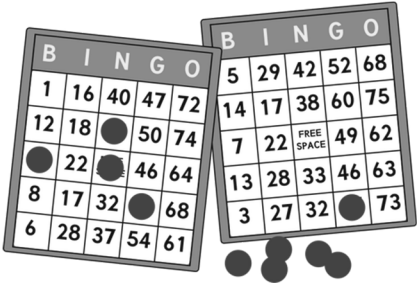
July 17, 18, 24, 25
