REV. DR. DONALD KEITH GILLETT, II

Rev. Dr. Gillett has deep roots in the Kentucky region. He was called as the General Minister and President of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Kentucky in May 2021 and began his ministry on August 1, 2021. He served 22 years as senior pastor of East Second Street Christian Church in Lexington. He also served four years as the Executive Director of the Kentucky Council of Churches and continues to serve as a contingent faculty at Lexington Theological Seminary.

In addition to Rev. Dr. Gillett's current work, he has extensive experience at the local, regional, and denominational level.

Reverend Dr. Gillett has four children, Jeremy, Liyah, Tasia, and Donald III (Trey) and three grandchildren, Jayda, Taeshawn, and Amaya. He is married to Dr. Charisse L. Gillett, President of the Lexington Theological Seminary.

"I live by the passage in Ephesians," said Rev. Dr. Gillett. "The gifts he gave were that some would be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until all of us come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to maturity, to the measure of the full stature of Christ."
