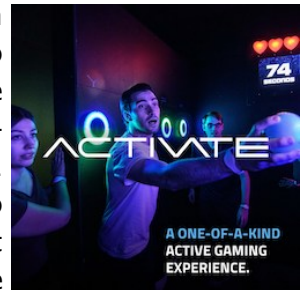

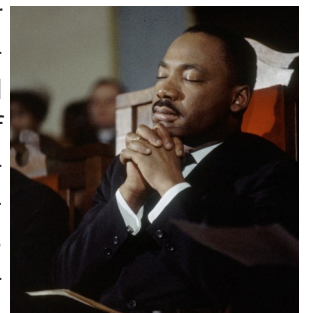


SHALOM SOCIAL JUSTICE TEAM MEETING
